Two Year Report of the Orgone Institute Press, 1950-1951

I. PUBLICATIONS

1. *Orgone Energy Bulletin (OEB)*

The OEB, quarterly periodical of the WRF, is now completing its fourth year of existence. Beginning with the January, 1950 issue, the Bulletin was enlarged from 48 to 64 or more pages, and the yearly subscription price was raised from \$2.00 to \$4.00.

2. *Orgone Energy Emergency Bulletin*

The Orgone Energy Emergency Bulletin was established to keep the public informed on the "Orgonomic Anti-Nuclear Radiation Effects Project" (ORANUR). The first number, a 12-page issue published in December, 1950, described the factual bases for experiments on the anti-nuclear radiation effect of cosmic orgone energy, and outlined the prophylactic and therapeutic problems. It was published in a 2000 edition. Over 1,000 copies were distributed to key people in governmental, scientific and educational agencies for their information. (The first *results* of the First Oranur Experiment appeared in the October, 1951 issue of the OEB, a double-sized issue of 159 pages, which was completely devoted to the subject. See paragraph 6 below.)

3. THE ORGONE ENERGY ACCUMULATOR. *Its Scientific and Medical Use*

This booklet of 56 pages with 26 photos, appeared in June, 1951, in response to a growing need and demand for a simple pamphlet about the orgone energy accumulator. It was published in a 3000 edition.

As a public service, this booklet is available free upon request by a librarian or official of an educational, scientific or medical organization. It has been requested so far by about fifty organizations, including state hospitals, clinics, psychoanalytic institutes, public welfare associations, counseling services, child guidance centers, educational boards, and university and city libraries, in the U.S.A. and abroad.

4. COSMIC SUPERIMPOSITION. *Man's Orgonotic Roots in Nature* by Wilhelm Reich

This book, which is an elaboration of a lecture presented by Reich at the Second International Orgonomic Convention, August 26, 1950, was published in a 3000 edition in November, 1951. It contains 127 pages with 39 line cuts and 12 photographs.

5. ETHER, GOD AND DEVIL by Wilhelm Reich

This work, which was originally published in the *Annals of the Orgone Institute*, No. 2, was brought out as a cloth-bound book in November, 1951, as a companion volume to COSMIC SUPERIMPOSITION. It was published in a 1000 edition.

6. THE ORANUR EXPERIMENT *First Report (1947-1951)* by Wilhelm Reich

This work was published as a paper-bound book in an edition of 1500 copies simultaneously with its publication in the October, 1951 issue of the OEB. It was brought out in book form to make the material more widely available, as the October, 1951 issue of the *Bulletin*, due to its double size, could be sold at Bulletin price to subscribers only.

As a public service, this book is available free upon request by a librarian or official of an educational, scientific or medical organization. It has been requested so far by approximately 45 organizations, mainly by hospitals, clinics, research institutes, social service institutes, universities and schools in the U.S.A. and abroad.

7. *Collected Edition Project*

The project of preparing for publication over the next six years, a collected edition of Reich's complete writings was begun in the Spring of 1951. There were two main reasons for this project: 1) Many important articles on sex-economy and orgonomy are not available in English, and 2) sections of the work which have appeared in different countries and at different times would appear far more comprehensible to the reader if brought together in thematic volumes which show clearly the logical, historical development of the science of orgonomy. So far, the work on this project has consisted of gathering together articles, notes and translations which were missing from the archives, the pasting up and thematic arrangement of articles that appeared in various periodicals at different times, the preparation of a full bibliography of Reich's writings, the almost-completed translation of an unpublished German sociological manuscript, PEOPLE IN BONDAGE, and of Reich's papers on the "Basic Antithesis of Pleasure and Anxiety" and "The

Bio-electrical Experiments" and several early articles by Reich including "Drive Concepts from Forel to Jung" and "The Tic as Masturbation Equivalent."

II. SALES

In the past six years, 1945 through 1951, over 35,000 copies of the publications of the Press were sold. During the past two years, over 12,500 copies were sold. In 1951, sales of books declined about one-third from the previous year, as no new books were published until late in the year. A new publication gives impetus to sales of all publications. Nonetheless, all volumes have continued to sell steadily; thus, during these two years sales included approximately 900 copies of DISCOVERY OF THE ORGONE, Vol. 1; 350, DISCOVERY OF THE ORGONE, Vol. 2; 1,150 CHARACTER ANALYSIS; 500 LISTEN, LITTLE MAN!; 600 volumes of *The International Journal of Sex-economy and Orgone Research*; 1,000 subscriptions to the *Orgone Energy Bulletin*, etc. The *Orgone Energy Emergency Bulletin*, No. 1, which was not announced to the general mailing list, sold over 800 copies.

THE SEXUAL REVOLUTION is out of print, but the Press is buying 500 copies of an edition being brought out in England in 1952 by Peter Nevill, Ltd. and Vision Press, Ltd.

The Press is handling sale in this country of the *Internationale Zeitschrift für Orgonomie*, official organ of the Orgone Institute Research Laboratories in Tel Aviv, Israel.

III. SALES PROMOTION

1. *Advertising campaign*: Ads announcing the publications of the Press appeared in such journals and magazines as the *New England Journal of Medicine*, *The New York Times Book Review Section*, the *Psychiatric Quarterly*, *The Nation*, *Nordisk Medicin*, *Annals of the American Academy of Political and Social Science*. These ads were not designed as "selling" ads, but as simple *informative* ads, the purpose of which was not to create immediate sales but rather to announce the existence of books on the discovery and use of cosmic orgone energy.

2. *Catalogue*: A new catalogue, describing the contents of each book and periodical, was printed in an edition of 10,000 copies. This catalogue was designed to give the reader some idea of the scope of the published works on orgonomy. An original mailing of 7,000 copies, though mailed late in the Spring of 1951, brought a good response, bringing summer sales to a higher level than previous summers.

3. *Exhibitions:* The books on orgonomy were exhibited by various book dealers at the 17th International Psycho-analytical Congress in Amsterdam, the American Psychoanalytic Association Convention, the American Psychiatric Association Convention, the New York Library Association Conference, the American Booksellers Association Conference, the New Jersey Library Association Conference, the Canadian Library Association Conference and the American Library Association Conference.

4. *Mailing List:* The Press' mailing list was increased by about 2,500 names to about 7,500.

5. *Listing:* The publications had a wider listing in such book reference sources as *Publisher's Trade List Annual*, *Library Journal*, *Books in Print*, and various guides of periodical literature.

6. *Agents for foreign distribution:* Peter Nevill, Ltd. and Vision Press, Ltd. of London, the Press' agents throughout the British Empire (with representatives in Australia, New Zealand, Tasmania, S. Africa, India, Pakistan and Great Britain), have sent orders through regularly, increasing sales abroad by about one hundred percent. Johan Grundt Tanum of Oslo, Norway, stocks the Press publications and circulates the Press' catalogue for development of sales in Norway. Wepf & Co. of Bale, Switzerland and Dr. Oprecht (bookseller) of Zurich, Switzerland, have requested quantities of the new catalogue for distribution to special customers. If sales develop from these mailings, they will stock the publications on consignment. Quantities of the new catalogue have also been sent on request to other bookstores here and abroad for distribution to special customers. These include the Librairie de L'Université, Geneva, Scheltema & Holkema, Amsterdam, etc.

7. *Agents in the U. S. A.:* The wholesale distribution of publications is now handled by The Baker & Taylor Co., Hillside, N. J. All publications are kept in stock on consignment by the Four Seasons Bookstore in New York City, and all of the books are stocked on consignment by Robert Brunner, Bookseller, New York City.

IV. FOREIGN PUBLISHERS

Peter Nevill, Ltd. and Vision Press, Ltd. of London are joint publishers of an English edition of *CHARACTER ANALYSIS* which appeared in 1950, and are bringing out an English edition of *THE SEXUAL REVOLUTION* in the Spring of 1952. L'Arche, a Paris firm, is bringing out a French edition of *DISCOVERY OF THE ORGONE*, Vol. 1, in 1952. Publishing houses in Italy, Denmark, and

Switzerland are interested in publishing editions of Reich's works in their respective countries.

V. THE ORGONE INSTITUTE PRESS AS PUBLISHING HOUSE OF THE WILHELM REICH FOUNDATION

The Orgone Institute Press, Inc. of New York, was dissolved in January, 1951, its assets and liabilities were transferred to The Wilhelm Reich Foundation, and it was formally taken over as a department of the Foundation. The Press' headquarters and mailing office in New York were moved to Orgonon, Rangeley, Maine, in 1950. Address: Orgone Institute Press, P. O. 153, Rangeley, Maine, U. S. A.
