

Financial Report of the WRF

The WRF rests on income. Its income derives basically from services rendered to the public with orgone energy, and from medical and educational services (OR energy accumulator devices, lectures, clinics, courses, etc.). The non-scientific administrative expenses have been limited to 15 to 20 per cent of the total income at present. Provisions have been made that with an increase of the total income, the administrative expenses should be gradually reduced. The administrative expenses comprise expenses which are necessary for the functioning of the WRF, such as bookkeeping, maintenance, secretarial work, legal and accounting services, etc.; administrative expenses which are incurred in direct connection with research, medical or educational services are subsumed under their respective grant.

No one receives a grant unless his research work or services are of a basic scientific nature, and have become socially valuable or have the prospect of becoming socially valuable in such a manner that they pay or will pay their own way. It is inherent in the work of the Foundation to regard basic research as *fundamental* to its *total* existence. It was basic research which made its present financial position possible in the form of the orgone energy accumulator devices which, at present, carry a large part of the cost of present and future basic research through their public services.

This procedure excludes obviously aimless, unconnected or disjointed approaches to natural-scientific problems. On the other hand, any idea—it may appear ever so much beyond probability—will be supported if it shows inner consistency and logic and is, in one way or another, related to problems of basic natural science.

All federated institutions are interested in and depend on the efficiency of basic research in physics, bio-energetics, medicine, education, etc. Therefore, they are obliged to contribute to its security. Their contribution is included in the one-third of their gross income which they pay toward the general overhead expenses.

All income goes into a common pool from which the actual expenses of

the various functioning units are paid. Each unit is, through its director, represented on the Board of Directors of the Foundation which meets annually, or whenever necessary. At the annual meeting of the Board of Directors, every director of a unit is obliged to give a report on his activities. These reports are a major requirement and a test of the continuous efficiency in the functioning of the respective unit.
